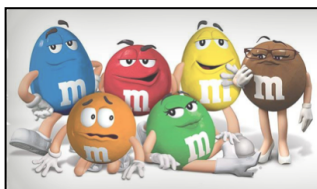
Science - We completed our first unit on Rock Patterns. Students did a wonderful job with their learning, and they will be using their knowledge as we move to Changing Land.
