Reading/Writing - In reading, we worked on visual content in fiction and nonfiction stories, making connections to texts, and the power of words in texts. . In writing, we finished our Misulonas Magazines and wrote letters to family for BTSN. We also started talking about narrative writing..

Math - In math, we started a new unit on addition and subtraction. We worked on mental math strategies, estimating, and adding large numbers. Students should practice their facts each night.

Science - This week, we started a new unit on Changing Land. Students learned meanings and moves for the vocabulary weathering, erosion, and deposition. We were able to see this vocabulary in action with an experiment showing how land weathers and erodes with water and wind.

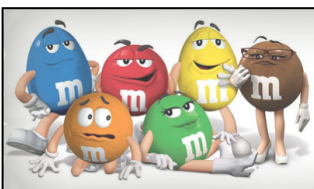
